Tarine (Ty) Fairman has over twenty-nine years (29) experience with the Department of Justice and Department of Defense. As a Special Agent with the Federal Bureau of Investigation, he specialized in International Terrorism and Foreign Counterintelligence. During his tenure in the FBI he has worked numerous cases involving the procurement and proliferation of chemical biological warfare materials to countries on the United States' National Security Threat List, as well as, the identification, interview and arrest of the world's most-wanted terrorists, kidnappers and individuals providing various forms of material support to terrorism.

As a member of the FBI Evidence Response Team and Hazardous Materials Team, Mr. Fairman has provided investigative and forensic analysis for a myriad of cases, most notably; the 9/11 World Trade Center Attack, New Jersey Anthrax Investigation, the kidnapping and murder of former Wall Street Journal Reporter Daniel Pearl, Egypt Air 990 plane crash, International Protestant Church Bombing, Islamabad, Pakistan, numerous Al-Qaeda Safe-House raids throughout Pakistan and the capture of Abu Zubayda, second in command to Osama Bin Laden, Faisalabad, Pakistan. Mr. Fairman was authorized and cleared for top-secret information and granted access to sensitive compartmented information. Presently, he maintains a Department of Defense Secret clearance.

Mr. Fairman is an honors graduate of Morehouse College, in Atlanta Georgia, where he earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree in sociology. After graduation, he was employed with the Federal Bureau of Prisons, at the Atlanta Federal Penitentiary in Atlanta, Georgia. He was a member of the Special Operations Response Team and received numerous awards and two quality step increase for his exceptional performance and dedication to duty.

Mr. Fairman earned a commission, as an officer in the U.S. Army in 1994 and was assigned to the 202nd Explosive Ordnance Detachment, Ft. Gillem, Georgia. His extensive explosive ordnance training was paramount in the forensic analysis and investigation of the International Protestant Church Bombing, Islamabad, Pakistan, and the bombing attempt of a British transport vehicle at the British Consulate, Karachi, Pakistan in 2002. He hails as one of the only FBI Special Agents to have effectively conducted forensic analysis at suicide bomber scenes, where he briefed and taught Pakistani Government Officials, military and police officials scene preservation, crater

identification and recreating a bombing scene. His additional duties included the handling and detonation of thousands of unexploded ordnance on military bombing ranges. Prior to earning his commission, Mr. Fairman was a Fire Controlman in the U.S. Navy. He received extensive training and expertise in electricity and advanced electronics, to include the maintenance and operation of various fire control computers, radars, guide units, laser gyros, and data recorders.

As a Captain in the U.S. Army Reserve, Mr. Fairman was mobilized to active duty status from 11/22/2004 to 11/22/2005 to serve in Operations; Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom. His leadership and organizational expertise continues to account for the preparation of deploying units to Iraq, Afghanistan and Kuwait. He was also responsible for providing logistical support and training to all soldiers on Detainee Operations, Improvised Explosive Devices, Risk Management, International Terrorism and Middle Eastern Cultural Awareness. Mr. Fairman served as the Commanding Officer of HHC 2/309th Regiment, 72nd Field Artillery, 1st Army East and has personally trained over 5000 soldiers.

Mr. Fairman continues to provide unprecedented insight and knowledge on the global war on terrorism by providing terrorism training seminars to the Japanese Ministry of Justice, Philippine National Police, Massachusetts State Police, and U.S. Army, as well as being interviewed on CNN, NBC, NBC Dateline, CNBC, The Morning Show, Court T.V., Fuji Television in Tokyo, Japan, Canada Am, Canada CTV, Time Magazine and Forbes Magazine-Japan. He has been an invited keynote speaker at the World Conference on Disaster Management, Toronto, Ontario, Canada; an invited terrorist expert at a Columbia University, New York Preparedness symposium; Chair of the Program Committee and Moderator for the Symposium on Water Terrorism Prevention at the United Nations, New York; keynote speaker at the Risk Control Security Seminar (RISCON), Tokyo, Japan; and has provided terrorism and intelligence sessions at the Contingency Planning Expos in Washington D.C. and Las Vegas, Nevada. He has been a regular guest on the Michael Eric Dyson Show, Warren Valentine Show and other Radio-One shows, where he presided as their terrorism and intelligence expert. In addition, in September 2005, Mr. Fairman authored his first book, outlining mass transit terrorism in Tokyo, Japan and has had his memoirs written and published in October 2009 in Tokyo, Japan.

Mr. Fairman, presently, conducts commodity procurement operations throughout West Africa, Financial Compliance and Business Intelligence Operations, and Asset Recovery Cases globally. In addition, he conducts Risk Assessments throughout Africa and consults on various Energy, Mining, Security, Travel and Logistic projects. His international security company has offices in Japan, Ghana and Sierra Leone. He was licensed to conduct security consultation and operations in Sierra Leone in April 2011.
